Dear Parents/Guardians,

As we approach the end of another school year, we wanted to clarify the **Presentation of Learning** days as printed in our school calendar.

June 23, 2017:

Grade 9s only (grade 7s and grade 8s do not attend school this day)

- Grade 9 students will attend during their scheduled appointments only to complete their Readiness Action Plan (RAP) presentation. Students are free to go once their presentation and reflection are complete.
- **This presentation will be included as a component of the Health and Career Education curriculum.**

June 26, 2017

Grade 8s only (grade 7s and grade 9s do not attend school this day)

- **Grade 8 students will attend school for the entire day.**
- **Students will take part in Passion Project Presentations.**
- **Students will be assessed on their ability to demonstrate progress within the Core Competencies (see below for more information).**
- **The activities on this day are a component of the Health and Career Education curriculum.**

June 27, 2017

Grade 7s only (grade 8s and grade 9s do not attend school this day)

- **Grade 7 students will attend school for the entire day.**
- **Students will take part in Passion Project Presentations.**
- **Students will be assessed on their ability to demonstrate progress within the Core Competencies (see below for more information).**
- **The activities on this day are a component of the Health and Career Education curriculum.**

It is important to note that the Presentation of Learning days fall within regular instructional time; therefore; attendance is expected. District school busses will run according to the regularly scheduled times. If students are unable to attend, then we would expect that students and families will have made arrangements with their classroom teachers to complete the assigned work at another time. June 28th is a completion day for students who have not yet met the requirements of the curriculum in all subject areas (i.e. unresolved "Incomplete" letter grades from previous terms). **The Presentations of Learning fall within this category and we would expect any student who does not complete the assigned work to attend on these days to demonstrate their learning of the assigned curriculum.**

We hope that these culminating tasks will help students to reflect upon their growth and achievements. Meaningful reflection is a critical element of learning and we appreciate your support as we help students to engage in these processes.
