Course Description:

This course is designed for students who have a strong work ethic and wish to experience leadership roles at Dr. Knox. Students are expected to create, plan and organize activities for all grade levels through theme events, in school and community projects, and assemblies. All Leadership 9 students have required service hours, within the school and the community that must be achieved for each term. Spaces are limited.

Course and Classroom Expectations:

- Students are expected to cooperate and work collaboratively in group situations
- Students are expected to be **active and vocal** participants during class discussions and planning sessions
- Students are required to contribute to activities outside of regular school hours
- Students will have a Leadership portfolio in which to record service hours and make journal entries
- Students are expected to be positive role-models within our school community

Assessment and Evaluation:

Your assessment will be comprised of a combination of self-assessments and teacher assessments each term (50% participation, 25% Leadership hours, 15% Self Evaluation, 10% Journals). Students will be assessed in the following areas:

- Attitude, cooperation, participation
- Service hours will be recorded and evaluated
- Leadership and organizational skills will be evaluated when facilitating Leadership events; reflections and self-assessments will also be used
- Leadership projects, group and individual activities, and research assignments
