2 PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

- 1. 2025 Projection Planning
 - a. Glenmore numbers are up, Belgo only has one, DRK is right at the cusp of enrolment.
 - b. French might need three sections, depends on how many students stay in the French stream.
 - c. Expected to have 60-70 more students.
- 2. KSS Catchment
 - a. KSS is the goal for a lot of DRK students, however those who fall outside of catchment are not guaranteed a spot at KSS.
 - b. This usually affects French immersion students the most.
 - c. Current have 944 grade 9 students and 12 families are dealing with this.
 - d. It is DRK's job to talk to the families, not KSS.
- 3. Budget Check-in (PAC Funding)
 - a. Not much that has been allocated has been spent.
 - b. Ideally it would be spent soon.
 - c. No concerns that it won't be spent.
- 4. VP Appraisal
 - a. We received more parent surveys than ever 10%!
- 5. Construction Update
 - a. The new wing should be open by September 2025.
 - b. The Food Labs can be moved in before, and it was suggested that the students in the class can help setup the kitchens in the new space.
 - c. The ART rooms will be retrofitted back.
- 6. Winter Sports Update
 - a. More community/parent engagement was needed for the Grade 8 sporting event. Discussed a revised approach for how to relay that to parents so the events are not cancelled.
 - b. The Grade 9 girls basketball team is doing very well and they might even go to provincials.
 - c. The Grade 9 boys basketball team is doing well (not going to provincials however).
 - d. Field hockey is still going.

3 PAC BUDGET UPDATE
